


ASSIST – Application for Social Services and Internet Screening Tool – is an internet site where you can apply for Delaware’s social service programs on-line.

On **ASSIST**, you can get information about and apply for many programs like cash assistance, Food Supplement Program, and medical assistance.

You can use **ASSIST** any time, day or night, from home, a library, a health care clinic or any place with Internet access.

What are the benefits of ASSIST?

Access via the Internet

ASSIST uses the Internet to provide an easy way to apply for Delaware’s social service programs. Applications can be submitted any time. You do not have to miss work or other important day time activities in order to apply for help.

Eligibility Screening

ASSIST has a screening tool. On **ASSIST**, you can enter information about you and your family. **ASSIST** checks the information you enter and gives you a list of services that you may be able to receive.

Improved Accessibility


ASSIST will help persons with disabilities apply for services. It reduces barriers for persons with visual, hearing, physical, or cognitive disabilities.

Community Partners

Community Partners can submit applications on behalf of their clients.

Secure and Confidential

ASSIST information is protected and secure. To protect your information, **ASSIST** will assign you a user identification and password. You can use your ID and password to look at an application you completed for up to 120 days. You can save an incomplete application for up to 30 days before you submit it.


