- Serves families from NJ, MD, PA & DE
- Provides care to a diverse group of low risk women
- Takes most insurances, including Medicaid and Medicare
- Provides extended client interactions to encourage good communication, patient engagement, and informed decision making



The Birth Center's Philosophy

- Women have the right to seek care that is medically safe, fits their lifestyle, and recognizes and respects their individual, physical, spiritual, psychological, and economic needs.
- Women and their families have the right and responsibility to assume an active role in their own health care.
- Childbirth is a normal, healthy process. The role of the caregiver is to support and promote this normal process, while recognizing and dealing with any deviation from normal. Confidence in this normal process is promoted.
- Because the family is the cornerstone of the social structure, maternity care must support and promote family unity and development. Family is defined by the client.
- Education is an essential part of quality healthcare. With knowledge freely exchanged, clients are encouraged to make informed choices.
- We are committed to providing evidenced based holistic care.



Long Term Goals

- Continue to provide an option to clients for out-of-hospital birth
- Increase the maternity caseload to 300 births per year
- Maintain a comprehensive educational program for parents
 - *Pre-conception through postpartum and early parenting*
 - *Increase the clients' self-help knowledge and skills with emphasis on active participation with their health care provider in maintaining optimal health*
- Provide well woman health care to women from adolescence through menopause
- Provide an out-of-hospital setting for the education of nurses and nurse-midwives
- Participate in research
