CERTIFICATES OF TRAINING

Partial credit will not be given. Certificates of training provided by the Summer Institute are not guaranteed to be accepted by every accreditation organization. Participants assume all responsibility for ensuring that the certificate of training will be accepted by their accreditation organization.

CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDITS

The spreadsheet on the previous page identifies workshops that have received pre-approval for CE credits by specific accreditation organizations. Please refer to the spreadsheet to determine whether a workshop has been pre-approved by a specific accreditation organization. Even if a workshop has been pre-approved, certain accreditation organizations may require documentation beyond the certificates of training normally issued by our office. Read carefully the information pertaining to each certification board listed below, in order to determine whether a specific accreditation organization will require additional documentation. If so, you will need to visit the Continuing Education station at the DSAMH Registration Desk in the hotel's lobby in order to obtain the required documentation.

CE: The DSAMH Training Office will award an individual certificate of training to each participant for successful completion of each workshop.

APA: Identified workshops are co-sponsored by the Delaware Psychological Association (DPA), and have been approved for APA credits. *(For those who do not need APA credits, other workshops may meet DPA CE requirements.)* The DPA is approved by the American Psychological Association (APA) to sponsor continuing education credits for psychologists. The Delaware Psychological Association maintains responsibility for this program and its contents. **Important Notice: Those who attend the workshop and complete the APA evaluation form prior to leaving the Summer Institute will receive the listed number of continuing education credits. APA rules require that we only give credit to those who attend the entire workshop. Those arriving more than 15 minutes after the scheduled start time or leaving before the workshop is completed will not be eligible to receive CE credits. There is a \$5.00 per credit fee required upon workshop completion. Checks must be made out to DPA. Cash and credit cards will not be accepted.**

CEAP (EACC): Certified Employee Assistance Professional (Employee Assistance Certification Commission). See spreadsheet for workshops pre-approved for Professional Development Hours for CEAP by the EACC. **After completion of your workshop, you must present your workshop certificate to the Continuing Education Station at The DSAMH Registration Desk in the hotel's lobby**, where you will be provided with an approval number and other documentation required by the EACC in order to receive Professional Development Hours.

CRCC: Commission on Rehabilitation Counselor Certification. See spreadsheet for workshops pre-approved by the CRCC. **You must present your workshop certificate to the Continuing Education station at the DSAMH Registration Desk in the hotel's lobby** in order to receive a CRCC Participant Verification Completion Form.

DBN: Delaware Board of Nursing (DBN). The DSAMH Training Office is an approved provider of Continuing Education credits under the rules and regulations for mandatory education set forth by the DBN.

DCB: Delaware Certification Board. See spreadsheet for workshops pre-approved by the DCB.

NAADAC: National Association of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse Counselors. The DSAMH Training Office is an approved NAADAC education provider.

NASW (DE): National Association of Social Workers (Delaware Chapter). See spreadsheet for workshops pre-approved by the NASW (DE).

NBCC: National Board of Certified Counselors. The DSAMH Training Office is an NBCC Approved Continuing Education Provider (ACEP™) and may offer NBCC-approved clock hours for events that meet NBCC requirements. The ACEP™ solely is responsible for all aspects of the program. Provider #5047.

NHA: Delaware Board of Examiners of Nursing Home Administrators. See spreadsheet for workshops pre-approved by the NHA.

PT: Delaware Examining Board of Physical Therapists and Athletic Trainers. See spreadsheet for workshops pre-approved by the PT.

DPA: Delaware Psychological Association
