

BCC - 1000 SEPTEMBER 2012 WEBINARS: QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS (as of September 25, 2012)

Q: What can the quick check do?

A: The quick check can be used as a free pre-check for employment. With little data entry, you can check the Adult Abuse, Certified Nurse Aide, Office of the Inspector General, and Public Sex Offender Registries.

Q: Will the federal criminal background report be available instantly?

A: The federal report can take up to six (6) weeks to obtain. However, unlike today, the BCC will contain the report electronically. This will save time to access the report as it will not be mailed from the FBI.

Q: Can fingerprints be cross referenced from other state agencies?

A: There is currently no access for cross referencing fingerprints across state agencies. As employers, you will be responsible for obtaining fingerprints from each job applicant. However, if the job applicant was fingerprinted by another BCC employer within the last three (3) years, there will be no need to obtain new fingerprints for the applicant. The BCC will let you know if there are fingerprints available for the job applicant within the last 3 years.
