RECIPROCAL RECOGNITION OF OUT-OF-STATE RADIATION SOURCE

The Delaware Radiation Control Regulation Section B.16 requires that any person who intends to bring a radiation source into the State for any temporary use must give written notice and receive approval by the Agency at least 2 working days before said source is to be used in the State of Delaware.

Complete the top portion of this form and attach a copy of your radiation source registration certificate or license from your home state or the U.S. NRC. Incomplete forms will be returned.
