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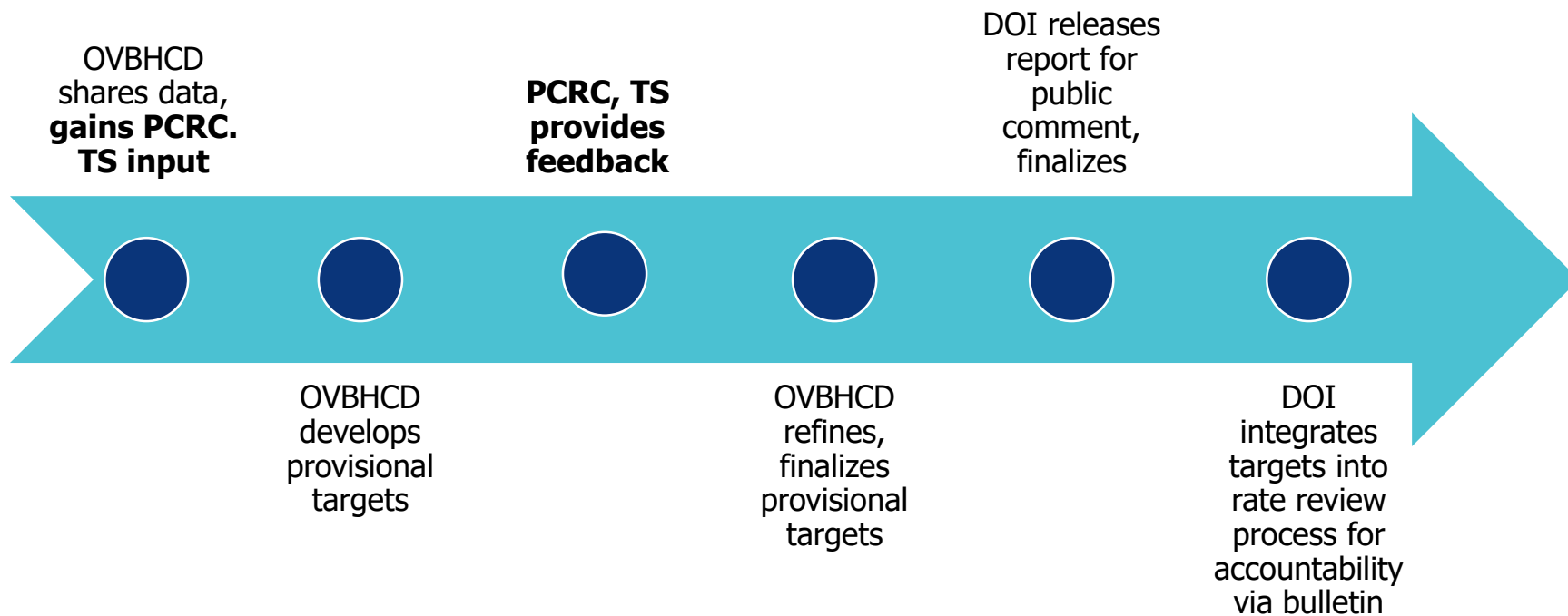

Recap of OVBHCD Work

- ▶ Established provisional affordability standards
 - Primary Care Investment Target
 - Provider Rate Review within the Payer Rate Review Process
 - Alternative Payment Model Targets
- ▶ PCRC TS: 3 of 5 meetings complete; Recent topics calculating primary care spend, approaches to alternative payment model targets
- ▶ Payers completed templates; analysis underway
- ▶ Met with 20 stakeholder groups; some multiple times

Affordability Standard Target Development Process



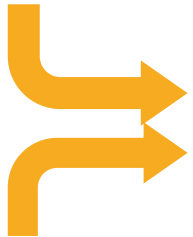
Defining Primary Care Spending



DIRECT

Funds flow clearly to primary care provider

Fee for Service
(e.g., office visit)



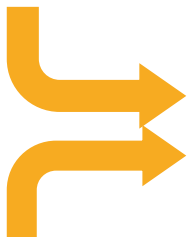
Non-Fee for Service

(e.g., care management payment)

INDIRECT

Funds flow typically to larger entity for distribution

Fee for Service
(e.g., facility fee)



Non-Fee for Service

(e.g., risk settlement payment)

Data Collection Update

- ▶ DOI Data Collection
 - ▶ Reviewed previous payer rate filings
 - ▶ Developed supplemental data collection template on affordability standards, updated template based on stakeholder feedback, and trained payers on completion
 - ▶ Data submitted on last week (9/16); analysis ongoing

- ▶ CMS Data
 - ▶ Federal Medical Loss Ratio Reports, Cost Reports, ACO Performance Reports

- ▶ DHIN Claims Data (*ongoing*)
 - ▶ Compare commercial primary care reimbursements to Medicare fee schedule
 - ▶ Analyze trends in cost and utilization by care setting
 - ▶ Evaluate primary care facility fee payments (indirect, FFS)

Stakeholder Discussions Update



- ▶ Stakeholder groups include:
 - ▶ Multi-stakeholder groups
 - ▶ State agencies
 - ▶ Payers (including SBO and Medicaid to discuss alignment opportunities)
 - ▶ Provider trade associations
 - ▶ Providers (health systems and independent providers) – ongoing
 - ▶ Self-Insured Purchasers – ongoing
 - ▶ Consumers - ongoing

Stakeholder feedback incorporated into data collection process and to be incorporated in target setting, shared in Affordability Standards Report
