Project Updates

- EVV Statistics as of August 18, 2023
 - 84 of the 95 providers who provide services subject to EVV have registered with Sandata
 - 240,087 visits from 40 different providers are reflected in the production environment with 234,948 (98%) in a verified status
 - Providers who are using alternate EVV systems must review their visit data in the Sandata aggregator and confirm verified status

Project Updates

- Fewer than half of all registered providers are submitting visits
 - If you need help and plan to use Sandata, email decustomercare@sandata.com.
 - If you need help and use an alternate EVV system email DEaltevv@sandata.com and put "DE ALT EVV" in the subject line.

• DMMA has determined that the procedure codes for pediatric services (SADC for kids and pediatric respite) are the same as the adult codes.

Common Pitfalls

- Providers have not registered the MCDID for which the MCOs are sending authorizations
 - All MCDIDs used for services applicable to EVV must be registered with Sandata
 - Many providers have more than one MCDID. DMMA, Mercer, Gainwell and the MCOs have been reaching out to providers to help align
 - All partners have encountered some level of issues while implementing required follow-up actions. This delayed progress; however, some issues have been or continue to be addressed

Common Pitfalls

- It is critical that the MCDIDs registered with Sandata are the same MCDIDs that the MCOs are using on prior authorizations
 - The MCOs send a PA file to Sandata and this is the mechanism to match members, providers and MCOs
- Providers using Alternate EVV vendors must make sure that the vendor is sending visits to the correct MCDID
- Sandata does not submit claims. You must continue sending claims to the appropriate payer

Provider Record from DMES to Sandata Provider Identifier = MCDID

Providers only see clients that have authorizations submitted for the MCDID used to log in.

Authorization Record from Payer to Sandata

Client Identifier = Medicaid ID
Provider Identifier = MCDID (crosswalk by MCO)

The Payer must submit the authorizations under the same MCDID used to record the visit.

Visit Record from AltEVV to Sandata or Sandata internal

Client Identifier = Medicaid ID

Provider Identifier = MCDID

If using an Alt EVV vendor, the Alt EVV vendor must submit visits with the same MCDID as used on the authorization.

Claim Record

Client Medicaid ID = Medicaid ID

Provider Identifier = MCDID (crosswalk by MCO)

The claim must be submitted with the same MCDID as the authorization and the visit.

Schedule

- ACDE and HHO will begin post-payment validation in the fall.
 - If there is any issue with matching a visit with a claim, the MCO will outreach the provider and provide education regarding the issue and how to avoid the issue in the future.

No claim will be denied for lack of visit verification until January 2025

 The expectation is that issues will be identified and addressed, and all providers will be comfortable and adept at using EVV prior to the hard edit.

Schedule

- Delaware First Health (DEFH) will begin pre-payment validation in the fall (date TBD)
 - If there is any issue with matching a visit with a claim, DEFH will outreach providers and provide education regarding issues and remediation.
 - DEFH will not deny payment for lack of visit verification until January 2025

 Delaware EVV program is here! All providers should be registered with Sandata, collecting visit data, and, if using an alternate EVV vendor, submitting visit data.

Schedule

Provider forums have been extended through the end of the year.
 DMMA will share updates and information as it is available; however, we intent to use this time for "Open Office Hours". All providers are invited to share barriers and concerns and seek solutions.

Medicare/Commercial Insurance

- Visits where Medicare or another insurance is the primary payer, even if they are not paying in full, are not subject to EVV and should not be entered into Sandata.
- Medicare crossover claims are not subject to EVV.
- In general, most services subject to EVV are not covered by Medicare and/or commercial insurance.
- Medicare and some commercial insurances cover some Home Health Services (the G-codes, listed in the service code list) under certain circumstances.
