Closure of Food Establishment Due to Imminent Health Hazard

The Division of Public Health (DPH) formally mandates you to Cease and Desist all food establishment activities effective immediately at Brew Ha Ha, Wilmington, DE. Delaware law, 16 Del. C § 122 establishes the authority for the Department of Health and Social Services to regulate food establishments. On November 26, 2019, imminent health hazards were identified during a routine inspection. In accordance with 8-404.11 of the State of Delaware Food Code, imminent hazards exist due to gross insanitary conditions and a pest infestation.

Prior to resuming operation, The Division of Public Health (DPH) shall inspect Brew Ha Ha (N119014). Reopening without prior approval of the Division of Public Health will result in fines up to \$1,000.
