Closure of Food Establishment for no hot water

The Division of Public Health (DPH) formally mandates you to cease and desist all food establishment activities effective immediately at Caribbean Cuisine (Dover Mall Kiosk), Dover DE. Delaware law, 16 Del. C § 122 establishes the authority for Department of Health and Social Services to regulate food establishments. During a routine inspection of Caribbean Cuisine at the Dover Mall (kiosk), the hand wash station at this location could not provide or maintain at least 100-degree Fahrenheit water temperature. In accordance with 5-103.11(B), of the State of Delaware Food Code, Hot water generation and distribution systems shall be sufficient in meeting the highest of hot water demands throughout the food establishment. Per your approval to add catering to an existing food establishment located at a Dover Mall Kiosk, a requirement to operate at this location was that of possessing a portable hand wash sink that generates and sustains a water temperature of at the least 100 degrees Fahrenheit.

The Division of Public Health prohibits all food establishment activities until you have provided a water source that meets the requirement during hours of operation. Reopening your establishment without prior approval of The Division of Public Health will result in fines up to \$1,000.00.
