Dear Penza Enterprises:

Closure of Food Establishment Due to Imminent Health Hazard

The Division of Public Health (DPH) formally mandates you to cease and desist all food establishment activities effective immediately at Ciao Pizza, Wilmington, DE. Delaware law 16 Del. C § 122 establishes the authority for the Department of Health and Social Services to regulate food establishments. On November 6, 2019, imminent health hazards were identified during a complaint inspection. In accordance with 8-404.11 of the State of Delaware Food Code, imminent hazards exist due to gross insanitary conditions and a pest infestation.

Prior to resuming operation, Ciao Pizza (N982263) shall be inspected by DPH. Reopening without prior approval of the Division of Public Health will result in fines up to \$1,000.
