Closure of Food Establishment Due to Imminent Health Hazard

The Division of Public Health (DPH) formally mandates you to cease and desist all food establishment activities effective immediately at Mom's Pizza, Wilmington, DE. Delaware law, 16 Del. C § 122 establishes the authority for Department of Health and Social Services to regulate food establishments. On April 1, 2019, gross insanitary conditions were identified during a complaint inspection. In accordance with 8-404.11 of the State of Delaware Food Code, imminent hazards exist due to gross insanitary conditions.

Prior to resuming operation, Mom's Pizza (N025120) shall be inspected by DPH. Reopening without prior approval of the Division of Public Health will result in fines up to \$1,000.
