
Closure of Food Establishment for Roaches

The Division of Public Health (DPH) formally mandates you to cease and desist all food establishment activities effective immediately at The Number 1 Chinese Restaurant, Dover DE. Delaware law, 16 Del. C § 122 establishes the authority for Department of Health and Social Services to regulate food establishments. Upon inspection of Number 1 Chinese Restaurant, roaches were observed (both adult and nymphs) in kitchen and bathroom area of establishment. In accordance with 6-501.111, of the State of Delaware Food Code, the premises shall be maintained free of insects, rodents, and other pests. And 8-404.11, onset of gross insanitary occurrence or condition or other circumstance that may endanger public health.

The Division prohibits all food establishment activities until you have eliminated the presence of pests from this establishment. Reopening without prior approval of The Division of Public Health will result in fines up to \$1,000.00.
