
Closure of Food Establishment for Failure to Obtain a Permit

The Division of Public Health (DPH) formally mandates you to cease and desist all food establishment activities effective immediately at Quality Sub Market, Wilmington, DE. Delaware law, 16 Del. C § 122 establishes the authority for Department of Health and Social Services to regulate food establishments. An inspection on 8/30/19 found that a change of ownership occurred without approval from the Division of Public Health. In addition, please refer to the State of Delaware Food Code for information regarding prerequisites for operation of a food establishment.

The Division of Public Health prohibits all food establishment activities until you have obtained a valid permit. Reopening without prior approval of the Division of Public Health will result in fines up to \$1,000.
