Adults



Bring these items:

- Hearing aid and extra batteries
- Eyeglasses
- Emergency contact name and information
- Health conditions listed
- Batteries for assistive devices
- Phone
- Personal care items
- Medications for seven days
- Medication delivery device and supplies





Don't forget your:

- Cane, walker, or rollator
- Wheelchair or scooter





Children



Children should:

- Know the first and last name and names of their parents
- Stay with a family member

Parents should bring:

- A list of health conditions
- Doctors names and numbers
- A list of medications
- Daily medication
- Diapers
- Formula
- Comfort item
- Clothing



People with Disabilities and Support Staff



Printed documents may include:

- Emergency contact person and their contact information
- Medications
- Health Conditions

You may need:

- Batteries for assistive devices
- Phone
- Disinfectant wipes
- Clothing
- Medical supplies
- Special feeding supplies
- Personal care items

Don't forget your:

- Cane, walker or rollator
- Wheelchair or scooter
