

1 lb. of dried beans/peas/lentils

16 oz. of whole wheat bread/tortillas

Exclusively Breastfeeding Women Receive:

AVERAGE VALUE

Example of monthly allowance:

6 gallons of milk

2 dozen eggs

36 oz. of cereal

(3) 11.5-12 oz. of concentrate juice

18 oz. of peanut butter

32 oz. of cheese

32 oz. of yogurt

30 oz. of canned fish

\$11 in fresh fruits and vegetables

1 lb. of dried beans/peas/lentils

16 oz. of whole wheat bread/tortillas

WIC (Women, Infant and Children) is a special nutrition program for pregnant, postpartum, and breastfeeding women, infants, and children under 5 years old.

WIC provides free nutritious foods to supplement your diet. WIC also provides breastfeeding support and nutrition education to help you and your children be healthy and eat well.

TO QUALIFY FOR WIC BENEFITS YOU MUST:

- ✓ Live in the State of Delaware
- ✓ Meet the income requirement
- ✓ Be in need of the special supplemental foods that WIC offers

Your child can stay on WIC until age 5.
