Enrollments

Annual VFC enrollments were sent to provider's offices, by mail, in December. If you have not received the enrollment packet for 2018 please contact the Immunization Program, 1-800-282-8672. The deadline for the return of the forms is January 31, 2018. Enrollment forms can be returned to the program by fax, 302-739-2555.

Required Annual Training

How to Register and Print Certificates for CDC's You Call the Shots Training (DE VFC Provider Training Requirement)

ONLY <u>TWO MODULES</u> MUST BE COMPLETED: <u>Vaccines For Children (VFC) and Vaccine Storage and Handling</u>

CDC updates the modules on an annual basis. Annual training is required for the Primary and Secondary/Backup VFC Contacts (Coordinators) in each VFC provider's office.
