The funds were spent on tombstone repairs, tree removal and shaping, driveway milling, ground penetrating radar, topsoil, fencing, mausoleum door and step railing, a sign, a lawnmower, and a chainsaw. The Board encourages the owners or managers of distressed cemeteries to apply for funds. The cemetery must be registered before an application is accepted.


