Delaware has a number of federally designated Health Professional Shortage Areas and Medically Underserved Areas seeking highly qualified physicians in the areas of family practice, internal medicine, obstetrics/gynecology, and psychiatry. Physicians choosing to practice in these areas may receive additional benefits including National Health Service Corps and State Loan Repayment opportunities, malpractice insurance coverage, and the opportunity to serve those most in need.
